



Product Data Sheet – SGS Limit Setting Module

The Safe Gaming System™ (SGS) is a complete “safety net” service designed for individuals who choose to gamble and for gaming operators who wish to offer their patrons SGS features. SGS both protects registrants from developing problems and provides analysis of actual gambling behavior.

SGS provides individual “service modules”, which incorporate the various features of the system. This allows subscribing gaming operators to provide custom, effective, system features that are essential to assist patrons to avoid the issues of excessive or inappropriate gambling.

The social mission is to reduce and/or eliminate the harm to people caused by gambling issues and to elevate the perception by patrons and regulators of gaming operators who adopt SGS.

One service module is the **SGS Limit Setting Module**. This product may stand alone to provide a self-administered, Web-based assessment of a patron’s affordable gambling limits.

The module is accessed from a direct link provided by the sponsoring gaming operator from a Website or any Internet-connected location or device, such as a kiosk.

All SGS service modules have been professionally designed and tested by experts in the field of responsible gaming. The limit setting module leads the participant through a process that accurately determines appropriate individual monetary and time limits for gambling activities over a given period.

Key specifications and features of the SGS Limit Setting Module are:

- * **An introductory page** identifies and recognizes the gaming entity sponsoring the provision of the responsible gaming tool for the patron’s use. Clear, step-by-step instructions are provided to derive the user’s personal gambling limits.
- * **Long and short calculation guides are provided to derive discretionary income.** For those users that are very familiar with their personal financials, a short form may be used. For other users, a detailed format is provided where income and expenses are calculated based upon user estimates.
- * **An SGS algorithm is applied to user calculations of discretionary income to present suggested limits.** SGS treats gambling expenditures and time limitations as recreational activities to derive personal suggested limits for the individual.
- * **The user can opt to view an acceptable “range” of limits.** The user can examine a low to high range of gambling expenditures within which financial losses would not be financially damaging.
- * **The user can store the limits chosen for personal gambling limits.** Limits decided upon may be securely saved for future reference. The user can retrieve the stored limits, time and date of determination, along with the calculation details that were input at the time.
- * **Stored limits may be updated or modified as the user’s financial factors change.**
