



## About The Safe Gaming System™

**The Safe Gaming System™ (SGS) is a “safety net” service designed to protect consumers that choose to gamble and for gaming operators who wish to offer their patrons the SGS features. SGS both protects registrants from developing problems and provides specific analysis of actual gambling behavior.**

**The SGS service recognizes that gambling is a very popular recreational activity that millions of people enjoy, and it provides effective, reasonable controls, which are essential to avoid the issues of excessive gambling.**

SGS is a patented system, which provides universal, individualized gambling controls for its registrants, and many significant advantages for gaming operators. SGS' technology serves to reduce and prevent the development of gambling issues (i.e. “problem gambling”).

SGS safeguards its registrants from developing problem gambling issues by encouraging “pre-commitment” to a maximum level of affordable gaming entertainment expenditures and time devoted to gaming. The agreement between SGS and its registrants is intended to ensure that gambling expenditures do not exceed a level that is affordable, without causing harm, to the individual. SGS includes a means to jointly establish and adhere to an appropriate gaming budget.

The social mission is to reduce and/or eliminate the harm to people caused by inappropriate gambling and to elevate the perception by patrons and regulators of gaming operators who adopt SGS.

The SGS is software-oriented so that it can be configured to work with a wide variety of operators' hardware and software systems.

**Among other features, the key services provided by SGS are:**

- \* A personal, secure **self-assessment** of each SGS registrant for susceptibility to gambling problems.
- \* **Ongoing screening for problem gambling behavior** and provision of referrals and guidance for assistance.
- \* Guidance, initiation, and control of **personal gaming parameters** (including time and loss limits) employed in SGS.
- \* **Pre-commitment to maximum gaming expenditures** based upon affordability.
- \* **“Cashless”** gaming transactions, where supported by venue technology.
- \* **Enforcement of limits** during gambling sessions at legal venues.
- \* **Debiting/crediting of an SGS account** for cashless gaming activities.
- \* **Interchangeability** of SGS debit card with SGS venues' “players' cards.”
- \* Ability to **register** SGS venues' **“players' cards”** for the venues.
- \* **Real-time monitoring** during gambling, with user communication only as needed.
- \* Online educational programs and gaming **tutorials**.
- \* **Reports of gaming activities/behavior** and SGS recommendations.
- \* **Referral service for professional assistance**, as needed, at SGS-affiliated Resource Centers.
- \* Self /or/ legislated **venue exclusion management**.
